


Additional Care Supplement (ACS) - Postnatal

Overview

This training guide will explain how to complete a postnatal ACS claim, as well as show the amounts that are available to claim.

Step by step

First you will need to log into Tiaki. If you don't have a login or you've forgotten your password, please get in touch with MMPO.

- 6. Select midwife**: A callout points to the 'Select Midwife' dropdown menu.
- 7. Select Women**: A callout points to the 'Select women' dropdown menu, which shows 'Women or NHI12345'.

8. Complete all questions within the form and click/tap *Send claim* once you are happy

NOTE when selecting the woman/pregnant person

★ By default, the "Select Women" field gives you a drop-down list of only the people who are currently in your care.

Click on "Search all woman by Name/NHI" to enable the system-wide search (which will remove this drop-down list and instead look at all the records in BadgerNet).

Your screen should now look like this:

3. Once you've enabled the system-wide search, please enter her NHI.

Note that when entering her NHI, the message "Loading results (can take up to 10 seconds)" will display. This confirms that you're doing a system-wide search through all records in BadgerNet and not just those that are in your Tiaki.
